Terminology and background

ERG – European Regulators Group (discontinued)

- Established: 2002 by Commission Decision 2002/627/EC
- An advisory group to the Commission
- Members: National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) of Member States + EU Commission

BEREC – Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (has replaced ERG)

BEREC

Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications

- Established: 2009 by Parliament & Council Regulation (EC) No 1211/2009
- Composed of the Board of Regulators (BoR) representing members
 NRAs of 27 Member States
- Not a legal entity
- Content work of BEREC is organised into Expert Working Groups






BEREC Office

- Established: 2009 by Parliament & Council Regulation (EC) No 1211/2009
- Community body with legal personality
- Support organisation of BEREC
- Comprises of:
 - Management Committee (MC) with following members: NRAs of 27 Member States + EU Commission
 - Administrative Manager and BEREC Office staff






Structure of BEREC & BEREC Office

Primary Objectives of telecoms Regulatory Framework

Role of BEREC

- Develop and disseminate among NRAs regulatory best practice
- Provide assistance to NRAs (upon request)
- Deliver expert opinions on Regulatory Framework
- Issue reports, provide advice to Commission, deliver opinions to European Parliament and Council (upon request)
- Assist Commission and NRAs in relations, discussions with 3rd parties, assist with dissemination of regulatory best practices to 3rd parties





Role of BEREC Office

- Professional and administrative support to BEREC
- Collect information, exchange and disseminate regulatory best practices among NRAs
- Assist the Chair of Management Committee (MC)/ Board of Regulators
- Set up BEREC Expert Working groups and provide support to those groups
